I have problems holding a pick between my index finger (which is fused solid and an inch shorter than my right hand) and second finger, so I use the purple Surfrocker for chords and would like the heavier versions for picking, as my left hand now gets tired very quickly.

I wasn't all that good right handed, but still enjoy the challenge of changing hands. Your pick system helps a lot and I don't drop the pick anymore.

Unfortunately I won't be using it in the future because if the hard plastic striking sound the pick generates. This sound is lessened substantially if I squeeze the pick hard, causing the two sides to squeeze together to reduce the effect of the vibrating between the two sides but, I'm sure you'd agree that you don't want want to be holding a pick like that, and even with the squeezing the clickey plastic sound is not eliminated completely. You recently sent me a sample of your F-1 guitar pick. (That wasn't one of the options in the ?How did you find us?? field of your guestbook). I have two comments.
1) The bend in the overlap which curls up seems to me to be too severe. It makes it awkward for me to hold the pick and was distracting. Perhaps if it didn't curl up so high it would be less obtrusive.
2) Are you going to offer the pick in other sizes? I typically use the fender jazz picks (the little ones) in a size heavy. That could be part of the reason that the pick seemed awkward to me. I like the smaller picks so that I can roll them up between my fingers while fingerpicking or plucking two or three strings.
